

# Shopko Teammate Community Service Grant

## ***Purpose***

Teammates who volunteer their time for a non-profit organization in their communities are eligible to submit a grant application to the Shopko Foundation on behalf of the organization. Our goal is to contribute to those charitable causes that are supported in a meaningful way by our teammates.

## ***Eligibility***

If you are a full-time or part-time Shopko teammate with at least six months service and you have actively volunteered your time and talent to a non-profit organization for at least one year, you may qualify for a Teammate Community Service Grant. The grants are for \$1000 each.

## ***Guidelines***

- The organization must be designated as a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization.
- The teammate volunteer must be an “active” participant in the organization, preferably in a leadership role and must have been actively involved with the organization for a minimum of one year.
- Religious, political, labor, and fraternal organizations are ineligible to receive a grant. Shopko reserves the right to exclude from this program any organization that for any reason is not an appropriate recipient of these funds.

## ***Application Procedure***

If you volunteer for an organization, meet the criteria outlined above, and would like to be considered for a Teammate Community Service Grant, please complete the application and submit to: Shopko Foundation: c/o Pam Schwanke, 700 Pilgrim Way, P.O. Box 19060, Green Bay, WI 54307-9060.

- Applications received by April 1st will be considered for the May award.
- Applications received by October 1st will be considered for the November award.
- Teammates may re-apply if their application meets guidelines but was not previously approved.
