Eligible Charities







All 501(c)(3) nonprofit (or global equivalent), tax-exempt public charities, except religious and political organizations, are eligible to receive matching funds through UnitedHealth Group's employee **giving!** program.

To be eligible for a matching gift through the giving! program, an organization must be:

- Recognized as a non-profit, tax-exempt organization or public charity by the appropriate local governing body (for example, in the U.S., this is the Internal Revenue Service which dictates which organizations are eligible under Code 501(c)(3))
- An accredited public or private college, university or K-12 school
- A governmental unit benefiting the public, such as a library, under 170(c)(1)

The following categories of organizations are ineligible for consideration:

- Nonprofit political organizations that promote a political party or candidate, or agencies whose primary objective is advocacy
- Houses of worship or religious organizations, except for accredited colleges, universities and schools noted above, and well-established

- religious organizations and programs that primarily provide social services
- Private foundations (e.g., sole funding source, no public donations accepted), community foundations, family funds or donoradvised funds
- Agencies, clubs and groups that are not classified as 501(c)(3) public charities
- Fraternities and sororities, including gifts to their affiliated foundations
- As determined by UnitedHealth Group in its sole discretion, organizations whose philosophy, mission or activities are inconsistent with UnitedHealth Group's core values or public policy positions, or whose work is controversial, conflicting or potentially damaging to UnitedHealth Group's business or industry
